OPTION PLAYER POLICY

Boys Baseball of Aurora recognizes four types of Option Players for both the Major and Minor Leagues. They are a Brother Option where a new player has a brother on the same team at the same time, a Manager Option where a player's father is managing a team in the League, a Sponsor Option where a father sponsors a team in the League, and a Coach Option where a father has coached on that team in the League for the previous four seasons. Each type of Option Player is assigned to a team as a pick in specific rounds of the draft, however, each Option Player is still required to register.

Manager's who believe they have an Option Player are responsible for completing the Option Player Application Form and submitting the required documentation to the Board of Directors prior to the annual Manager's Meeting. The Board will review each application. If approved, the Manager will be notified. The Board has the discretionary authority to move Option Players in the Major League, up or down in the draft order to maintain a competitive balance in the League.
