BACKGROUND CHECK POLICY

Boys Baseball of Aurora conducts authorized, independent, confidential, third-party background checks on all Board Members, Managers, Coaches, Umpires, and Volunteers associated with the League. All volunteers are screened through Protect Youth Sports against the National Criminal Database, the National Sex Offender Registry, and the State of Illinois Court Search. All Managers and Coaches must be approved by Boys Baseball of Aurora prior to the start of practices. Parents are made aware of approved volunteers and are encouraged to report volunteer help beyond those approved. Volunteers who do not consent to or pass the League approved screening process are forbidden to participate in any League sponsored event, practice, or game.

A Manager Review Committee is in place to monitor Managers and Coaches throughout the season. Behavior not in full compliance with our Code of Conduct is addressed immediately with repercussions defined in our Rules. Boys Baseball of Aurora also requires parents of all boys to abide by a written Code of Conduct monitored by the Managers and League.
